General Rules for CPD Credit

- RCPATH CPD credit is calculated as "1 credit = 1 hour" excluding breaks.
- Minimum credit is 0.5 for a 30-minute academic session.
- Maximum credit allowed is 7 per day.
- Additional academic activity may also be awarded credit accordingly.

Total duration: 180 minutes [3.00 credit]

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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) on CPD Credits

1. What is a CPD credit?

CPD stands for Continuing Professional Development. A CPD credit is a formal measure of participation in structured educational activities that help maintain and enhance professional skills, knowledge, and performance.

2. Who awards these CPD credits for BMUPATHCON2025?

The CPD credits for BMUPATHCON2025 are accredited by the Royal College of Pathologists (UK) — one of the world's leading authorities in pathology education and training.

3. Why is this significant?

This is the first-ever RCPATH CPD-accredited event in Bangladesh, marking an important milestone for our medical education and professional development community.

4. How many CPD credits can I receive?

The maximum available CPD credit is 16 for participants who attend the full conference and take part in academic sessions or presentations. Partial attendance will earn proportionately fewer credits.

5. When will I receive my CPD certificate?

Certificates will be issued at the end of your participation in the conference — when you leave the venue and will not be returning. This ensures accurate attendance documentation as per RCPATH requirements.

6. Why can't the certificates be distributed at the beginning?

Unlike general certificates of participation, CPD certificates must reflect verified attendance and participation. Therefore, RCPATH policy requires distribution only after completion of the verified sessions.

7. What is the benefit of CPD credits for me?

CPD credits demonstrate your active engagement in recognized professional learning. They strengthen your academic and professional portfolio and may be used for career progression, licensing, or fellowship applications both in Bangladesh and abroad.

8. Do I need to register separately for CPD credits?

No. All registered participants of BMUPATHCON2025 will automatically be eligible for CPD credits, provided attendance and participation are confirmed.

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
